ADOPTED CODES

The City of Hallettsville City Council has adopted the following Codes into the local Code of Ordinances. These Codes are enforced on all permitted building projects. 1) 2009 International Building Code, 2) 2009 International Residential Code, 3) 2009 International Fire Code, 4) 2009 International Fuel Gas Code, 5) 2009 International Plumbing Code, 6) 2008 National Electric Code, and 7) 2008 NFPA 96.

CONTRACTOR LICENSE

It shall be the duty of every contractor who shall make contracts for the installation or repairs of a building, structure, electrical, gas, mechanical or plumbing systems, for which a permit is required to comply with state regulations, and the city's regulations and/or requirements. Contractors doing work within the City limits are required to obtain a Contractor License. The Contractor License fee is \$50.00 and is valid for a period of twelve (12) months from the date of issuance. A license may be renewed for a fee of \$25.00. A renewal license can only be issued if the contractor pays the renewal fee within twelve (12) months of prior license expiration. Before a contractor license may be issued or renewed the contractor must furnish the city with a current bond in the amount of \$5,000.00. All Electrical, Mechanical, and Plumbing contractors performing work in the City must be licensed by the State of Texas.

FLOODPLAIN MANAGEMENT

The City has passed a local floodplain management ordinance in order to promote the public health, safety and general welfare and to minimize public and private losses due to flood conditions in specific areas. If your project is located within the 100 year floodplain, your project may require an elevation certificate. Projects that are valued at more than 50% of the value of the property may trigger additional requirements. For more information refer to Section 3.500 of the City of Hallettsville Code of Ordinances.

RESIDENTIAL SETBACKS

Residential setbacks apply to all parcels within the City limits that are used, or proposed to be used, for residential occupancy. All structures are subject to the minimum setback requirements including, permanent buildings, covered patios, carports, and individual storage buildings. The setback requirement is the distance from your property line to your proposed structure. For more information refer to Section 3.700 of the City of Hallettsville Code of Ordinances.
