Community Invited to Review Preliminary Draft of Hallettsville’s Resilient Comprehensive Plan

The City of Hallettsville invites all residents, business owners, and community stakeholders to review and provide feedback on the **Preliminary Draft of the Resilient Comprehensive Plan**, now available through the city’s online engagement portal.

This long-range plan—funded through a **\$300,000 grant from the Texas General Land Office (with no cost to the city)**—will guide Hallettsville’s growth and development over the next 10 to 20 years. It focuses on strategies that promote sustainability, equity, and resilience, while addressing key issues such as land use, housing, infrastructure, economic development, parks and trails, downtown revitalization, stormwater management, and historical preservation.

“The preliminary draft represents months of thoughtful planning and public input,” said **City Mayor, Alice Jo Summers**. “We want to ensure the community has every opportunity to weigh in before the final plan is developed.”

 The final version of the Resilient Comprehensive Plan is expected to be adopted in **early 2026**.
